The Reproductive Health curriculum focuses on healthy relationships, puberty, anatomy and physiology of the reproductive system, sexual harassment, contraception, and how the media affects teen attitudes and behavior. This curriculum is taught by a licensed school nurse in collaboration with our local partners: Solace, Planned Parenthood and Resolve NM.

The purpose of the Reproductive Health curriculum is to present factual and accurate information and promote responsible relationships.

The program goals are:

- to reduce the number of teen pregnancies
- prevent sexually transmitted infections including HIV/AIDS, and
- to promote abstinence as the safest choice for teens.
